4	<p>There are two things that I did not particularly like about this class:</p> <p>Firstly, I found the things that we were learning frustrating in their scope. In some sections we would learn broad overviews of a topic, but then in another we would be expected to randomly remember the greek word for a backdrop or something. It just seemed odd to me. I think that either stronger communication about what level of detail we are expected to know would be helpful or perhaps if smaller sections of the textbook reading were assigned given the understanding that we really are expected to know everything in the reading very well.</p> <p>Secondly, I did not much enjoy recitation. I know that it was intended to be very interactive and everything, which is cool. However, it is super frustrating to be in a huge group of people when half of them don't seem to come to class most of the time, and you all have to suddenly collaborate despite the apathy of several group members. I know these are mostly complaints about students not caring as much, but I think it might have been good if at the beginning of the semester we had spent some time on "getting to know you" stuff since we would be spending so much time collaborating later.</p>
